Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) Grades 6-12

Dear Kuemper Families,

In our ever-changing technological world, it is important for Kuemper to remain competitive by providing a technology-rich environment for our students. Many public and private schools have provided or required one device per student in an effort to meet the growing need for technology integration within the classroom.

It is our technology mission to transform teaching, learning, and assessment in a Christ-centered academic environment by integrating today's digital tools to prepare all students for the challenges of the 21st Century.

The 2017-2018 school year is the fourth year of Kuemper's BYOD program with about 88% of our students bringing devices to school each day allowing technology to be integrated in most subject areas.

Because of the success of the BYOD program, Kuemper will no longer have devices available for daily check out starting with the 2018-2019 school year. Each student in grades 6 through 12 will be asked to bring their own device to school on a daily basis. If this creates an issue for your family, please contact Mr. Garringer for grades 6-8 or Mr. Haefs for grades 9-12 by June 1, 2018.

We will have a limited number of devices available for short term checkout (30 days or less) if a student's personal device malfunctions. These devices cannot leave the school property and must be turned in daily. We will not have devices available for students who forget to charge their device or forget to bring it to school.
