

rSchool System for Activities/Sports

What is rSchool?

rSchool is the online portal parents use to submit information for their child's activities and athletics (such as football, basketball, cheerleading, etc.). This is where parents submit physicals, health/injury information, etc.



How do I set up an account?

Parents must set up an account before their child participates in any sport for the year. Go to www.kuemper.org. There is a link to rSchool on Kuemper's registration webpage and also under the "Activities" tab. School Calendar

All Kuemper activities including sports, concerts, early dismissals, and much more can be found on the Kuemper website or Kuemper app. Families can access this online calendar and easily print off weekly or monthly calendars at their convenience. The calendar also has capabilities to import into personal electronic calendars. *Please note that changes are made very regularly to the calendar.*

What's so cool about the app?

The information families check most often is all easily accessed on the app. No more searching and scrolling the full website on your phone. Just open the app and the information is there! Information such as:

- Breakfast and lunch menus
- Phone numbers for each center/building
- Calendar of daily events
- School news



You can also allow the app to send you notifications. This is a great option for those who are not in Kuemper's student database but would still like to receive school notifications about closings, late starts, etc. (grandparents, day-care providers)

Text Message Notifications

How do I learn about school delays/cancellations and other information?

Kuemper uses text messages to notify of school delays, cancellations, etc. Parents and guardians must opt in to receive these messages.

How do I start receiving text messages?

Please opt into this free service by sending a text message of "Y" or "Yes" to the five digit number 67587.

Changes to BYOD

Grades 6-12 are under the BYOD (Bring Your Own Device) Program. Starting for the 2018-2019 school year, Kuemper will no longer have devices available for daily check out. Each student, grade 6-12, is being asked to bring their own device to school. If you have any concerns or questions please contact your building administrator.

Infinite Campus Parent Portal

What is Infinite Campus?

Infinite Campus is Kuemper's student information system. Through the parent portal, parents can access information such as their student's grades, attendance records, and lunch account information. You can also make lunch payments online in the parent portal.


What does Kuemper need from parents on their Parent Portal?

Kuemper asks that you update your information whenever necessary (if you change your phone number, address, or any important contact information). Kuemper will also ask you to log in every summer during the registration process to verify that all your information is up-to-date.

What is all in my Parent Portal?

There is a lot of information including grades, attendance, and lunch account information. See the graphic below.

Smart Tuition

What is Smart Tuition?

Kuemper uses Smart Tuition for the processing and collection of tuition. Smart Tuition provides many payment options (including online) and quick access to a family's tuition information.



Families who are entirely new to making tuition payments at Kuemper must set up an account. (Your oldest child will be a kindergartner or you're transferring from another school).

New families must go to www.enrollwithsmart.com and click "Create a New Account" to get started.

How do I access my account?

All Kuemper families have an account set up already (whether you realize it or not). To access your account, go to www.smarttuition.com and enter your username and password. If you do not know your username and password, click "Forgot Username and Password." You can call Smart Tuition's help line if you have questions (888)-868-8828.

What else is Smart Tuition used for?

Kuemper also uses Smart Tuition as a medium for families to pay for various items such as sports fees, yearbooks, and Century Club memberships. Payments from your bank account do not incur a service charge. However, payments from a credit or debit card will incur a convenience fee and will also show on your credit card or bank statement.

TADS Tuition Assistance Application

What is TADS?

The Sioux City Diocese (including Kuemper) utilizes the company called TADS for the tuition assistance application process. Applications are submitted to TADS and TADS designates the tuition assistance dollars to families that qualify.



When are applications due?

Tuition assistance applications are due April 1st of every year. Families that are new to Kuemper have an extended deadline of September 15th.

How do I apply?

Kuemper will notify families as soon as the online application is available after January 1st. Applying entails each family setting up an online account with TADS and submitting the form online along with supporting documents.

Lunch Program

How do I pay for my child's lunch?

Payments can be made either online through your Infinite Campus Parent Portal under the "payments" link, by sending payment to school with your child, or by dropping off your payment at school.

What if my child has a food allergy?

The foodservice staff at Kuemper can accommodate many food allergies. The staff currently offers gluten free and peanut free options and can make arrangements for other allergies. Please notify the foodservice director Sue Kennebeck if your student has an allergy at sakennebeck@kuemper.org.

What are alternate meals?

Kuemper offers an alternate menu item daily as a replacement for the main entrée. Please see the online menu for more information. Your child also has the option to bring their own lunch to school.

Kuemper's Scrip Program

What is scrip?

Scrip is like "substitute money" that earns you rebates towards your family's tuition and the school's general budget. When you purchase scrip from Kuemper, you are purchasing gift cards towards almost any store or business, both local and national. There is no extra money spent, just money earned. Each business sets their own rebate percentage.

Can anyone purchase scrip, even if they don't have kids at Kuemper?

Yes! Anyone can purchase scrip and designate their rebate towards any student! Grandparents, aunts, uncles, and friends have all contributed to some of Kuemper's top scrip earners.
