## Nurse's Note

Students entering 12th grade for the 2019-2020 school year are required by Iowa Immunization law to have 2 doses of meningococcal vaccine if they were born after September 15, 1999, or 1 dose if it was received when the student was 16 years of age or older. Vaccines can be gotten at your medical provider or St. Anthony PH. If you are unsure about your son/daughter's vaccine needs please call your medical provider or the school nurse. Please get this vaccine for your son/daughter if they haven't met the requirement before school begins next fall. Students are not allowed to return to school without meeting this vaccine requirement.
